Meet Gopi – Our One-Eyed Warrior

Stories of Survival from the Frontlines of Rescue



When Gopi was found wandering the streets of Govindpuri, she was in unbearable pain and completely blind. A maggot-infested wound had destroyed one of her eyes, and her fragile body bore the weight of days—maybe weeks—of silent suffering.

Our rescue team rushed her to the shelter, where our vets carefully cleaned the wound and removed a small tumor from her eye.

Despite her trauma, Gopi's spirit never broke. She's calm, gentle, and still wags her tail when she hears a kind voice.

But Gopi's journey to recovery isn't over. If her eye doesn't heal as expected, she may need another major surgery to remove it completely—something essential for her long-term comfort and safety.

Gopi is now a permanent resident at our shelter. She cannot survive the streets, and she will spend the rest of her life under our care, surrounded by love, protection, and compassion.

We've promised Gopi a second chance at life—but we can't do it without your help.
